PROGRAMME PROPOSAL

The Alpine Network of Protected Areas (ALPARC) coordinated by the Task Force Protected Areas of the Permanent Secretariat Alpine Convention introduced, since 2006, and at instigation of the alpine protected areas, a work of reflection on the theme of “efficiency indicators”.

The Swiss Parks Network starts in 2009 to study indicators to evaluate the effectiveness of measures in the management of protected areas in 5 categories:

1. Nature conservation and landscape protection
2. Traditional activities and sustainable development
3. Communication and environmental education
4. Management of protected areas (structures, staff,...)
5. Research activities

So ALPARC and the Swiss Parks Network decided to work together to elaborate a first proposition of a concept of indicators for the management of protected areas.

The aim of this meeting is the creation of a catalogue of indicators for management effectiveness (CIME).

This tool will be a support to improve the park’s performance and management system.
